The National Oil Shale Association (NOSA) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to oil shale education. We are not a lobbying organization. Our mission is to educate the public, media, elected officials and other organizations about the facts surrounding oil shale and its potential for supplementing the supplies of petroleum and transportation fuels in the United States and elsewhere in the world. NOSA has been reinstated from its earlier activities in oil shale in the 1970's and 1980's.

Any firm, organization or individual interested in joining is eligible for membership if it supports the mission of NOSA. The benefits of membership include access to current information on oil shale via a variety of on line and hard copy communications and through participation in association activities.

NOSA is seeking members in two classes of membership: Sustaining Members and Associate Members. Sustaining Members shall have the right to vote, serve as Committee members, elect Committee members and receive certain other benefits determined by the Committee. Associate Members shall be individuals or organizations and they are non-voting members. Associate Members shall not be corporations, divisions of corporations, firms, partnerships, or other such groups in business to make a profit. Associate Members shall not designate alternates, and may not serve as Committee members.

Dues and Fees are as follows: Sustaining Members - \$4,000 one time initiation fee and \$2,000 per year annual dues (\$6,000 due upon approval). Associate Members - \$100 per year annual dues (no initiation fee).
